

How do I access SCHOLAR?

Anyone can experience some of the material provided by SCHOLAR using http://scholar.hw.ac.uk/ and use the Try Scholar option on the left of the page.

Every SQA candidate registered to sit one or more of the courses covered in SCHOLAR can login using their own username (SQA number) and password (obtained from subject teacher, scholar coordinator or other school identified source). Candidates will then have full access to courses on which they are enrolled.



Live Online Sessions

We're now going into our second year of delivering our online, subject-specific, homework and revision sessions. These live one-hour sessions have proven extremely popular with students. Looking at the evaluation forms, the students overwhelmingly enjoy the opportunity to ask questions and receive instant answers from our subject experts. It's also proved particularly beneficial for Advanced Higher students who may study independently or in smaller groups.

Using Scholar on Mobile Devices.

Can I use SCHOLAR on Android and iOS (Apple) tablets? The quick answer is YES. While SCHOLAR are transitioning all the Flash interactivities over to a new open format called HTML5, the use of SCHOLAR and its Flash interactivities on mobile devices can be used by installing the Puffin Academy app. This is a free mobile web browser available for download.



Timescale of new developments

The new CfE Advanced Higher courses are currently under development and it is anticipated that the full materials will be available for all courses in January 2016. CfE Advanced Higher students will be provided access to the old Advanced Higher as support material in 2015/16.
